Styrofoam, plastic bags, coat hangers, light bulbs, window glass, metal objects, automotive containers, frosted blue or black bottles, foam packing peanuts or mixed trash.

TRASH PICK-UP

- (1) Trash shall be placed at curbside no sooner than 7:00 p.m. the day before regular pick-up and no later than 7:00 a.m. the day of regular pick-up. Empty containers shall be removed from curb before 7:00 a.m. following the day of collection.
- (2) City provided wheeled 95/68 gallon trash containers shall be placed away from obstacles such as trees, poles, fire hydrants, parked cars, and spaced one foot apart from other containers. Handles must face opposite of street and when filled shall not exceed 200 lbs.
- (3) City trash crews will not pick up building, remodeling or demolition material. No contractor debris will be collected. No appliances, tires, scattered refuse or hazardous materials will be collected.
- (4) Collections will not be made on the legal holidays of New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. When a holiday occurs on a weekday, pickup for the remaining days will be one day late. Friday collection will be made on Saturday.
- (5) Additional containers are available upon request; a fee of \$10.45 per month per container will be assessed.
- (6) Moveout/Cleanout (8 or more additional bags, cans or bulk items) can be placed for collection on your normal trash day pick-up. All additional items are to be neatly placed, bagged, and/or boxed for collection in addition to city wheeled trash cart. A fee of \$100.00 will be assessed.
- (7) Nuisance Fee (min. of \$150.00), disposing of scattered trash/debris, removal of unacceptable material or trash placed out early.

YARD WASTE PICK-UP

- Bay City's yard waste program runs from April through November each year, with compostible materials being collected weekly on resident's regular trash pick-up days.
Yardwaste is not to be placed inside city trash containers.
- (1) Yard waste includes leaves, grass clippings, and vegetative debris from City residences.
 - (2) Yard waste must be placed in kraft yard bags or in a thirty-two gallon or less container with handles, that is marked Yard Waste Only and weighing no greater than 40 lbs when filled. City crews will **not** collect plastic bags, cardboard boxes, grocery bags or other non-approved containers.
 - (3) Trash, such as cans, glass, plastic and paper products should not be included with yard waste. Food waste or animal waste is not to be included with yard waste.
 - (4) Kraft paper bags may be purchased at local retail and hardware stores.
- Compost Available**
- Compost is available for purchase through the City of Bay City. (April – October)
Fees are as follows:
\$12.50 per yard, loaded by the City;
\$ 5.00 per yard, self-load;
\$ 5.00 commercial rate (50+ yards) per yard, loaded by the City;
Delivery charge;
\$35.00 residential, per small load
\$55.00 commercial, per large load
Large load – 3 yards or greater
- Prepayment is required at the City Service Building located at 800 S. Water Street.
- Compost returns organic matter to soils, increasing its water holding capacity & improving soil structure.

BRUSH PICK-UP

Collection Guidelines:

*Collected monthly April
through November
City's East Side*

Set brush out by the **1st** of each month, April – November. City crews will collect brush beginning from the south end City limit working north, from the 1st through the 15th of each month.

City's West Side

Set brush out by the **15th** of each month, April - November. City crews will collect brush beginning from the south end City limit working north, from the 16th through the end of each month.

Note:

Stack brush neatly between curb & sidewalk with cut ends facing in one direction.

Branches should be no larger than 5" in diameter.

Root balls are to be removed and placed with yard waste collection.

City crews shall not be responsible for the disposal of brush produced by Contractors.

Earth Day Event

On Saturday, April 17, 2010, in celebration of Ed Golson Earth Day, the City of Bay City will provide approximately five hundred yards of finished compost material for local residents for their gardening purposes.
