“All Together Now” Recycling Information

Cardboard, paper, plastic, glass, tin, and aluminum is collected WEEKLY and may be placed together in the same recycle container/bin. No need to separate. Plastics #1, #2, #4, #5, #6 & #7 are acceptable.

Not accepted are: #3 plastics, plastic bags and polystyrene (commonly known as Styrofoam)

Please place all recycling to the curb no later than 7 a.m. on your normal collection day.

COLLECTION SCHEDULE RULES & REGULATIONS

TRASH PICK-UP

(1) Trash shall be placed at curbside no earlier than 7:00 pm the day before regular pick-up and no later than 7:00am the day of regular pick-up. Empty containers shall be removed from curb before 7:00 am following the day of collection and stored out of public view.

(2) City crews will not repeat routes for trash placed out late. Hold until the following week.

(3) City provided wheeled 95/68 gallon trash containers shall be placed away from obstacles such as trees, poles, fire hydrants, parked cars, and spaced 3 feet apart from other containers. Handles of City provided trash containers must face the house for automated pickup.

(4) City crews will not pick up building, remodeling / demolition material or concrete. No contractor debris will be collected. No appliances, tires, scattered refuse, or hazardous materials will be collected. Do not place yard waste material in city trash containers. **Do not use cardboard boxes for trash.**

(5) Collections for legal holidays of **Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day**, will delay pickup by one day. Friday collection will be made on Saturday. For holidays not listed, collection will remain on schedule.

(6) Additional City trash containers are available upon request; a monthly fee per container will be assessed.

(7) **Per City Ordinance, all trash is to be contained within City trash can.** Move-out/Cleanout (8 or more additional bags, cans or bulk items) can be placed for collection on your normal trash day pick-up for an additional fee.

(8) Nuisance Fee (min. of \$150.00), if trash out early, unsightly and not **bagged properly.**

YARD WASTE PICK-UP

Bay City's yard waste program runs from April through November each year, with compost materials being collected weekly on resident's regular trash pick-up days.

(1) Yard waste includes leaves, grass clippings, and vegetative debris from City residences.

(2) Yard waste must be placed in kraft yard bags or in a 32-gallon or less container with handles, that is marked Yard Waste Only and weighing no greater than 40 lbs when filled. City crews will **not** collect yard waste material placed into plastic bags, cardboard boxes, grocery bags or other non-approved containers.

(3) Trash, such as cans, glass, plastic and paper products including food or animal waste is not to be included with yard waste.

(4) Cans with frozen yard waste will not be emptied as the cans might crack due to cold.

Compost Available

Compost is available for purchase from the City of Bay City. (April – October). Compost returns organic matter to soils, increasing its water holding capacity & improving soil structure.

Compost may be picked up or delivered within City limits for an additional fee.

BRUSH PICK-UP

*Collected monthly
April through end of November*

City's East Side

Set brush out by the 1st of each month, April – November. City crews will collect brush beginning from the south end City limit working north, from the 1st through the 15th of each month.

City's West Side

Set brush out by the 15th of each month, April - November. City crews will collect brush beginning from the south end City limit working north, from the 16th through the end of each month.

Stack brush neatly between curb & sidewalk with cut ends facing in one direction. Branches should be no larger than 5" in diameter. Keep brush piles away from obstacles such as fire hydrants and utility poles, and maintain safe line of sight distance for pedestrian and vehicular traffic.

Root balls are to be removed and placed with yard waste collection.

City crews shall not be responsible for the removal of brush produced by contractors or larger amounts of brush & limbs resulting from a tree removal.

Christmas Tree collection will run during **the week of 1/03–1/17/17**. Please have tree to the curb free of any Decorations for your weekly trash day.

Earth Day Event

On Saturday, April 22 2017, in celebration of Ed Golson Earth Day, the City of Bay City will provide approximately three hundred yards of compost material for local residents for their gardening purposes.
