HOW TO PREP

GLASS ITEMS



Food & Beverage bottles and jars. (All color glass),
No ceramics, pyrex, plate glass or mirrors.

Washed
(Labels can be left on)

PAPER PRODUCTS:



Newspaper, magazines, junk mail, catalogs, envelopes (including those with windows), wrapping paper, telephone books, Paper bags, milk cartons, Juice boxes and frozen food boxes.
NO tissue paper, hand towels, napkins, paper plates or cups.

Free of food residue
Shredded paper in CLEAR plastic bags
Boxes and cardboard must be flattened

TIN/STEEL CANS, SCRAP METAL, ALUMINUM



Metal food and beverage cans, containers and lids. Pots & pans, metal trays, pie plates. Clean foil (shaped into fist size balls).

Washed
(Labels can be left on)

PLASTIC BOTTLE #1, #2, #4, #5, #6, #7



Plastic yogurt & margarine tubs, frozen concentrate juice containers, coffee cans, frozen microwave trays, Berry boxes, salad/carry-out Containers and lids, cold drink cups (e.g. Sole), plant trays & nursery pots.
Also accepted: Bulky rigid plastics Such as hampers & lawn furniture.
NO Plastic bags or lids. NO Styrofoam or PLA (compostable plastics).
**** NO PLASTIC ITEM WITHOUT A NUMBER INSIDE A CHASING ARROW.**

Food tubs/containers should be washed.

Residential materials must be placed at the curb by 7 a.m. on your normal collection day
