


About the Memorial

The Bay City Fire Department Memorial was created to honor those firefighters of the Bay City Fire Department that have made the ultimate sacrifice.

The Memorial was built entirely with donations, and the sale of the landscaping bricks will create a fund for maintenance well into the future.

The Memorial block is made out of 7200 lbs of Missouri Red Granite. The Lion, that sits guard on top of the memorial, is over 100 years old. He is one of two Lions that were placed at the original Headquarters, located at McKinley & Adams Streets. He was then moved to the current location in 1974 at the Central Fire Station, where the monument was placed to honor the fallen Firefighters whom have made their Last Alarm.
